Dr. Bagrat Yengibaryan is a seasoned leader with over 25 years of executive management experience in private sector development, business incubation, acceleration, startups, and investment attraction. He has been the Director of the Enterprise Incubator Foundation (EIF) since 2002, where he oversees business development, marketing, promotion, startup creation, and management. Under his leadership, the EIF helps companies enhance their professional and business skills and fosters learning partnerships between industry, universities, and research institutions. As Director of EIF, Dr. Yengibaryan is a co-founder and advisory board member of Granatus Venture Fund, Armenia's first venture capital fund. He is also a co-founder and board member of the Engineering city, Microsoft Innovation Center in Armenia and the Center for Innovative Solutions and Technologies, as well as a board member of the Union of Employers of Information and Communication Technologies.

In addition to his roles in Armenia, Dr. Yengibaryan has served as an international innovation expert, providing consultancy to governments in countries such as Moldova, Ukraine, Montenegro and several in Latin America. Dr. Yengibaryan holds an MBA from the American University of Armenia and a Ph.D. in Mathematics from the Armenian National Academy of Sciences. He has authored 21 research papers published in local and international journals.

She received the title of EU Cluster Manager of the Year for 2019 from DG GROW, European Commission, and is involved in coordinating cross-sectoral collaborations across Europe. Bianca Muntean strongly believes that the power of collaboration can drive systemic changes in the economy and society.

Gerd Meier zu Köcker has been involved in global cluster development since 2007 and has shaped the German and European cluster landscape since then. He has founded the European Secretariat for Cluster Analysis (2010) to pave the way for the European Cluster Excellence Approach, which became an internationally recognized standard for cluster excellence (2011). As Director of the European Cluster Observatory (2013 - 2016), he designed the EU Smart Guide to Cluster Policy (2016), the guideline for sustainable cluster development in the EU. Gerd led the German Cluster Excellence Initiative "Kompetenznetze Deutschland" or "go-Cluster" from 2007 - 2014, where he was responsible for supporting the 100 best German clusters and networks. He currently leads the ClusterAgentur Baden-Württemberg, which supports and advises more than 120 clusters and networks. In 2020, Gerd developed the Cluster Development Guide, the blue print for sustainable cluster development. Gerd is a teaching at Kehls University and University of St. Gallen (Switzerland)
